LIVING HOPE SCHOOL is located in Nandanavanam slum colony of Saroornagar Mandal, Hyderabad.

The main occupations for these slum dwellers are rag picking from the rubbish dump and picking up garbage from the neighbouring wealthy colonies' residents, on tri-cycles and taking it to the dump. Children are forced into this profession to earn extra money. Sadly the money they earn is often used for drinking alcohol and other unhealthy activities. Many children in this colony are deprived of the right to education due to poverty, and because their parents are largely uneducated and don't understand the importance of education for their children.



With an aim to change the lives of these children, International Aid Trust India started Living Hope School. The School has been instrumental in improving the lives of hundreds of children since its establishment.



We run classes Nursery to 5th class. The students are aged between 3 – 14 years. The English medium education programme is provided by 7 dedicated and committed teachers, along with 2 support staff and a cleaner. The staff of Living Hope School thank God for the privilege He has given them to serve these poor children by giving them a free education.

If you are able to donate : £6.00 could pay for 1 child from the Nandanavanam slum to attend school for a month and get a nutritious school lunch each day. £180 could feed and educate a whole class for 1 month!
