Living Hope School serves the Nandanavanam slum colony of Saroornagar Mandal, Hyderabad. Families here survive by rag picking from the rubbish dump and picking up garbage to take to the dump from the neighbouring wealthy communities.



Young children are forced into this work to earn extra money. Many children miss out on education due to poverty



and because their parents are largely uneducated and don't understand the importance of school for their children.



With an aim to change the lives of these children, International Aid Trust India started Living Hope School. The School has improved the lives of hundreds of children since its establishment.



We run classes Nursery to 5<sup>th</sup> class. The students are aged between 3 – 14 years. The staff of Living Hope School thank God for the privilege He has given them to serve these poor children by giving them a free education.
