This is Lalita (pictured above and right), she is really grateful for all the skills she's learnt and can make dresses, skirts, blouses, trousers etc. She is able now to earn the equivalent of £40 a month which is enough to support her family. She wants to

recommend the training to other women. The sense of community and support between the group is another real benefit.
