In this pack are:

- I) the calendar of prayer points for each day.
- 2) the picture background and words to colour or decorate each day or week.

How to use this reflection:

- Create your background: Join the 2 A4 pages together and colour or paint the background: sky, stars, ground and manger.
- For each day there is a phrase from the Bible verse and thought to reflect on or an area of our work to give thanks and pray for.
- You could choose to colour in or decorate one of the words on the picture each day or on the day that word is used in the reflection.
- Use your imagination! How you colour / paint / decorate is up to you!
- Please adapt and use this resource as it works for you it can be done alone, with a child or as a family day by day; or as a group who meet weekly praying for those 7 areas at one meeting, or with a larger group at 1 meeting.
- The image is designed to fill an A3 sheet, but you can photocopy it larger to create a bigger finished picture.



provider. We pray we will bring all


our cares to Jesus trusting in his

16) We give thanks for all our volunteers in the UK shops, warehouse and office who make all that we do possible, through their time, care and skills. Please pray that they will be encouraged and know our Mighty God's help as they serve.


